9. Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc 2008 ~ Villa Maria, New Zealand Intense young & vibrant wine with herbaceous & gooseberry flavours & plenty of fresh acidity, the essence of New World Sauvignon.		15.95
10. Sancerre 2006 ~ 'La Perrière', France Rich sauvignon bouquet & crisp gooseberry fruit on the palate. Well made Sancerre with vibrant fruit characteristics.		18.95
11. Pouilly Fumé 2002 ~ Genetin, Domaine Tinel-Blondelet, France Full sauvignon on the nose with a palate that is mouth filling; round & full of fruit.		25.00

- 12. Italian Chardonnay 2003** ~ Trulli, Italy 13.95
This is a fine wine that combines a wonderfully ripe fruit & a slightly nutty oak character.
- 13. Bourgogne Blanc 2005** ~ Clos de Loyse, Louis Jadot, France 16.95
A rare single vineyard 100% oak barrel-fermented Bourgogne Blanc with natural fruit flavours that is ideal with a range of foods.
- 14. Private Selection Fume Blanc 2004** ~ Robert Mondavi, USA 16.95
Toasty oak with enticing pear, melon & spice flavours from a top Californian producer
- 15. Xanadu Chardonnay 2002** ~ Margaret River, Australia 17.95
A fine oaked Aussie Chardonnay that's bold & brash.
- 16. Cloudy Bay Chardonnay 2002** ~ New Zealand 25.00
The palate is rich yet refined with a chalky texture supporting the delicious mineral-like complexity and creaminess derived from traditional winemaking techniques
- 17. Puligny Montrachet 'Les Enseignères' 2002** ~, Roux Pere & Fils, France 35.00
White Burgundy with distinguished & distinctive aromas of almonds, fern, exotic fruit & white flowers. Wine at this level doesn't come any better; nose, taste and finish are all immaculate.

ROSÉ

- 18. Rosé 2007** ~ Florent de Brie, France 3.00 12.95
The bouquet is of raspberries & strawberries, really delicious off dry style with a hint of liquorice.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- 19. Prosecco Brut** ~ Canti, Italy 15.95
Fresh, lively sparkling wine from the north of Italy; pale yellow in colour with a hint of apples.
- 20. Sparkling Rosé** ~ Jacob's Creek 15.95
Many say that this is the perfect wine for celebrations being soft & round with a touch of strawberries; I think they could be right.
- 21. Veuve Clicquot Brut NV Champagne** 35.00
This Pinot Noir dominated champagne has a weighty richness and delicate, fruity freshness. It is perfect for those who shy away from the acidic nip of other champagne styles.

22. Fleurie 2006 ~ Chateau de Chenas, France		16.75
This gorgeous Gamay has a vibrantly fruity nose, and lovely body & mouth-feel. Gold medal at Paris 2007		
Soft rounded reds		
23. Merlot 2007 ~ Santiano, Chile	3.00	12.95
This is an easy drinking, fairly light, soft & juicy merlot with hints of blackberry fruit flavours.		
24. Pinotage 2007 ~ Fraser's Bay, South Africa		13.95
This is classic Pinotage, ruby red in colour, with sweet plums on the palate & a velvety smooth finish.		
25. Cabernet Franc 2002 ~ La Tunella, Italy		14.95
Herbaceous & peppery on the nose, ripe plums & cherries on the palate, soft tannins & an exquisite finish.		
26. House Claret 2004 ~ Château Lacroix, France		15.95
The second wine of Chateau Teyssier Grand Cru in St Emilion, this is a real joy to drink. It's soft & approachable with rich Merlot fruit		
27. Bourgogne Rouge 2005 ~ Louis Jadot, France		16.95
Classic generic Burgundy with delicate raspberry fruit flavours.		
28. Chateau Beaumont 2002 ~ Haut Medoc, France		22.50
Highly rated by American Bordeaux buff Parker this is classy claret – drink it and you will be sipping a Rolls Royce of wines		
29. Pernand Vergelesses 2003 ~ Louis Jadot, France		25.00
Chewy, robust dark stone fruit & cherry aromas with impressions of old vines, earth and leather are confirmed on this wine's palate in a broad, generous texture supported by firm, rustic tannins.		
30. Chorey les Beaune 2001 ~ Joseph Drouhin, France		32.50
Chorey is a light, supple, very moderately tannic wine. Its colour is of medium depth & its fine aroma is reminiscent of cherries & raspberries.		
31. Chateau Sarget 1994 ~ Saint-Julien, France		35.00
The second wine from Chateau Gruaud Larose; one of the best of the second wines with much of the class of the parent property.		
32. Gevrey Chambertin 2000 ~ Charles Vienot, France		35.00
Crafted in the most famous commune in the Cote d'Or & possibly in Burgundy, this is vibrant wine with a raspberry & strawberry character.

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Robust reds

- 33. Australian Shiraz 2005** ~ Gamekeeper's Reserve, St Hallet 3.00 12.95
A powerful blend of shiraz, grenache & touriga, with a smoky aroma & exuberant raspberry & cherry spice.
- 34. Cotes du Rhone 2004** ~ Chateaux La Renjardiere , France 3.00 12.95
Award winning spicy & full-bodied wine typical of the Southern Rhone.
- 35. Chianti 2005** ~ Trulli, Italy 12.95
This is full-bodied, dry wine with spicy aromas from Tuscany.
- 36. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc 2001** ~ Coonawarra, Australia 15.95
Rymill MC² is a blend of classic grape varieties providing intense fruit aromas, complex yet supple flavours & a soft finish.
- 37. Old Vines Zinfandel 2003** ~ Trulli, Italy 15.95
Made from vines over 40 years old it is rich & spicy with berry flavours; oak aging adds complexity & creates a long smooth finish.
- 38. Petite Sirah 2006** ~ L A Cetto, Mexico 15.95
This gem from Mexico has intense spicy baked fruit flavours with some vanilla oakiness & a smooth velvety finish.
- 39. Rioja 2003** ~ Baron de Ley, Spain 15.95
A classic example of Spain's most famous red; creamy vanilla oaked flavours, soft on the palate & a lasting full-bodied fruit finish.
- 40. Shiraz 2001** ~ Wolf Blass President's Selection, Australia 16.50
Dark red in colour with purple hues. Intense aromas of spiced fruit, chocolate oak characters with a hint of varietal pepper.
- 41. Pinot Noir 1998** ~ Robert Mondavi, California 22.50
Silky layers of cherry, raspberry & red plum intertwine with fragrant allspice & floral accents. Aging in small, French oak barrels adds spicy, toasty nuances that continue through the lingering finish
- 42. Nuits Saint Georges 2004** ~ Bouchard Pere & Fils, France 25.50
Good value wines can still be found in the Nuits & this robust oaked wine with a typically rich fragrance of aroma is one.
- 43. Musar 1999** ~ Serge Hochar, Lebanon 27.50
Legendary wine with the structure & elegance of a fine Bordeaux made in the Bakaa Valley by Serge Hochar. It is aged in oak for up to two years resulting in a wonderfully exotic and aromatic wine.

DESSERT WINES

- 44. Monbazillac 2000** ~ Chateaux Septy 11.95
Award winning classic Monbazillac that is rich, luscious & full of apricots, but with a sweetness that is not cloying. (Half Bottle)
- 45. Late Harvested Orange Muscat & Flora 2006** ~ Brown Brothers 11.95
Intense candid fruit & raisiny ripeness in a sip. (Half Bottle)
